

Terms of Payment

The Berlage Post-Master of Science in Architecture and Urban Design

Tuition fee

The tuition fee for the program is set at €18.000 per academic year. Thus €27,000 for the entire 18-month program. The tuition fee is to be paid in full before July 1. The payment of the tuition fee forms a part of the admission procedure. Only students that have made their payment in time can be admitted to the program. The payment has been made in time, when the full payment of the tuition fee and if applicable the Guarantee Amount, are received on our bank account before July 1. Please, be aware that when you apply just before the deadline of June 1, the tuition fee must still be paid before July 1. The Berlage also accepts confirmation letters of scholarship programs as payment, even though the payment has not been made yet.

Down payment

To confirm your admission, we ask you to make a non-refundable down payment of €750. This down payment is to be received within 3 weeks after you receive our financial letter. Please note that the down payment only secures your place in our program and does not start the visa and housing application process.

Living costs

Non-EU/ETFA nationals need a visa and/or residence permit for the Netherlands. TU Delft will apply for the MVV Visa and/or Residence Permit for Study at the Dutch Immigration Service (IND) on your behalf. It is not possible for you as a student to apply yourself. The IND requires Non-EU/EFTA nationals to temporarily transfer a living costs guarantee payment between €14.000 and €15.000 to demonstrate your financial solvability. The IND will announce this fee in January. We will communicate the precise amount with you when we send you our financial letter. The payment deadline for the living cost payment is also July 1. We will refund your living costs payment to your (Dutch) bank account in September, during the start of the semester. Make sure to bring sufficient funds to bridge the first few weeks after arrival in the Netherlands. Please note that, if applicable, we'll deduct the visa/residence permit fee and the accommodation handling fee from your living cost payment, before transferring the payment back to you.

Tuition Payment in installments

If you prefer we can offer you the option of paying your tuition fee in installments. Due to Dutch immigration law we can offer EU residents to pay the tuition fee in three installments, and non-EU residents to pay the tuition fee in two installments. Please contact us at info@theberlage.nl if you would like to use this option, and we will help you with the process. The tuition installment option requires you to sign with us a payment agreement, and is accepted by TU Delft to start the Visa and Housing service.

Additional study costs

There will be extra individual costs for printing, presentation materials and a contribution for the fieldwork trips. The estimated costs for the 3 semesters are about €3,500.

Please note that payment of the tuition fee (payment deadline is July 1) is part of your enrollment to our program. Currently there is a shortage on affordable student accommodations. TU Delft's housing services use your enrollment date as placement on their waiting list for housing. The sooner you are enrolled the higher you are on the waiting list.
